


Helping with Learning Difficulties

For students with Dyslexia and Learning Difficulties spelling is confusing and doesn't make sense words seem to run together reading is hard work and not fun

identifying beginning, middle and end sounds in words
learning tricky sight words
reading fluency
retrieving words from vocabulary

Learning to Spell

- 1. Read Three Free Wishes and listen for words with a Long E sound
- 2. Break words into sounds, eg s-ea, or s-ee
- 3. Spell the Long E sound words by saying each individual sound of the word and then the whole word, eg s-ea sea or s-ee see
- 4. The green letters show 12 different ways to spell the Long E sound





I for the Long E words all the same Long E Sound. word to spell e and end sounds I disconnected lists me, read to others ords in everyday use




