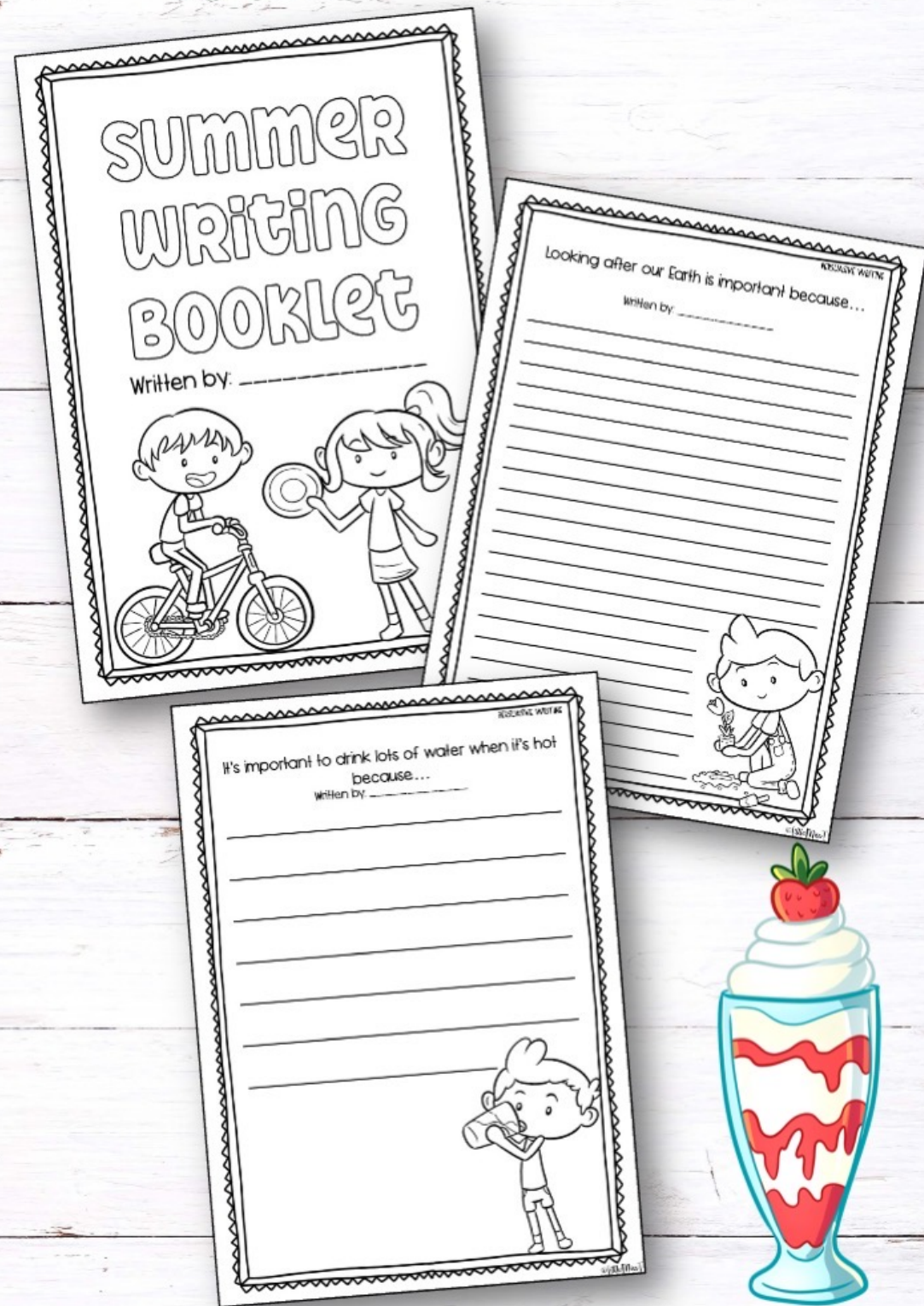

USES:

- ♥ Fast Finisher Activity – Print off as a fast finisher booklet or as individual sheets that students can select from.
- ♥ Fun Assessment – Informal assessment to see students writing skills
- ♥ Whole Class Activity – Hand out the same writing prompt to the whole class (can vary difficulty level based on student needs).
- ♥ Homework – Send home writing prompt as homework.
- ♥ Casual/Relief Teacher Activity – great writing activity for students K-4 as a quick print and go activity.
- ♥ Gifted or Extension Work – need to extend a particular student – give them this as an extra writing booklet to complete.
- ♥ Literacy Center Rotation – Have these printed based on each groups needs as a literacy center activity.
- ♥ Split Book – Choose a few of these to create a split book for those days you're away and need to leave some productive work.
- ♥ Independent Activity print off a range of prompts and leave out the front. Students go and select a prompt and write quietly.
- ♥ Small Group Activity – Students join into mixed ability groups with a blank paper and writing prompt paper. They discuss, plan and write together as a group.
