## Scroll see more!

There are three core components of reading fluency.

Fluency is the ability to read text accurately, quickly and with expression (prosody).


There is a very strong link between reading fluency and reading comprehension. It is so strong that they can be seen as interdependent.

Fluency can only occur if the reader understands what they are reading in order to be able to pause and phrase groups of words correctly. Similarly, if reading is labored and disjointed, reading comprehension is negatively affected.


