



Instructions


Activity Instructions

1. Complete the written activity
2. Colour in the animals face and/or pencil & eraser
3. Cut it out carefully: **DO NOT CUT OFF THE GREY GLUING TABS**
4. Glue the pages together using the tabs as a guide

Optional steps

- Back onto colour card (before cutting out)
- Laminate if possible (after cutting out , but before being joined)
 - Tip: Use a stapler to join if you laminate

How to Use?

1. Open using a computer in PowerPoint.
2. Click the editable text boxes.
3. Back space to delete the prompt ' Type Here'.
4. Start writing - The font is saved into the document.
5. Print the outline and connect it to the rest of the craft.
6. Print and glue on an animal image.
7. Or colour in the animal location on the world map.

TROUBLE SHOOTING


The editable PowerPoint and PDF resource is located in a separate folder should you wish students to use either file templates on a school computer for the purpose of printing this digital resource.

Please Read Before Use

- 1. SAVE WORK:** Ensure students save their work prior to leaving the computer or printing by using 'Save As' the 1st time they use this document. Afterwards, they can click 'Save' because the document has already made a separate copy.
- 2. DELETED ELEMENTS:** The document is flattened to prevent students from over-riding originals or deleting key elements of the document. If students do manage to delete an editable text box, first try the 'undo' button or 'CTRL Z' to reverse the error. If this does not work, they may need to begin again.
